

Snow Removal Ordinance

Just a reminder....snow must be cleared to create a safe path on sidewalks within 24 hours after the snowfall.

Snow Emergency Ordinance

All streets within the Borough are considered Snow Emergency Routes.

Phase I—there is no parking on all Borough streets including State Roads.

Phase II—all traffic is prohibited on all Borough streets including State Roads.

Snow Emergencies can be found on Channels 8, 21 & 43. Any questions may be directed to the Police Department 717-993-5308.

November-Open Burning

The Fire Chief is authorized to act on behalf of the borough to permit individual requests to open burn during the month of November and also for special events. Borough Council may at any time revoke permission to burn for adverse weather conditions. Please contact the Fire Chief each day you plan to burn at 717-324-2940. If no answer, leave a message containing the address, phone number and date at which you are burning. The Ordinance is available to

Ordinance 2007-6

An Ordinance requiring landlords to submit a tenant registration form within 14 days whenever there is a change in tenants. These forms may be picked up at the Borough Office or requested via fax or email.

Ordinance 2007-5

An Ordinance permitting all trash containers, recyclable containers or any other containers to be placed curbside as early as 12:00 noon prevailing time on the day before collection. All containers are to be removed from the curbside no later than 12 midnight on the day of collection. Each dwelling unit shall mark the containers with their house number.

2013 Street Projects

Street projects scheduled for 2013 include reconstruction of Griffith Avenue from Maple to Pennsylvania Avenue and new compacted stone surfaces for Maple and Pine Streets. Following the storm sewer replacement in West Pennsylvania Avenue in 2012, the Borough will now be performing restoration and repaving of the street surface. In the future, the Borough would like to rebuild East Pennsylvania Avenue including curbs and sidewalks and also Hill Street. Funds are insufficient at the present time to move forward with either of these projects.

Sewer & Water Authority

The Stewartstown Borough Authority's wastewater treatment plant continues to perform extremely well and as such will allow the Authority to participate in the Chesapeake Bay Nutrient Credit Trading Program as a seller of nitrogen and phosphorus credits. The Authority is in the process of renewing the General Permit for Class A, Exceptional Quality biosolids produced by its wastewater treatment plant in Hopewell Township. Rehabilitation and repair work will begin soon on two tanks at the treatment plant constructed in 1973. Rehab work on these two

tanks plus one other will continue into 2014.

The Authority is now reviewing options for completely rebuilding and enlarging Wellhouse #4, which was constructed in 1975. This is the oldest Wellhouse in Stewartstown's water supply system.
