AN ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF STEWARTSTOWN
BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING JUVENILES
SEVENTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER TO BE ON, REMAIN IN, OR
UPON ANY STREET, HIGHWAY, ALLEY, PARK, PLAYGROUND,
SIDEWALK, PRIVATE PARKING LOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, OR OTHER
PUBLIC PLACE IN THE BOROUGH BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11:00 P.M.
AND 5:00 A.M. UNLESS ACCOMPANIED AS HEREIN PROVIDED AND
IMPOSES CRIMINAL SANCTIONS FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of Stewartstown
Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority
of the same as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for juveniles seventeen years of age and under to be
on, remain in, or upon any street, highway, alley, park, playground, sidewalk, private parking
lot open to the public or other public place in the Borough between the hours of 11:00 p.m.
and 5:00 a.m. unless the said juvenile is accompanied by a parent, guardian, or any person

having legal custody of the said juvenile. The hours set forth herein shall be in accordance with whatever local time is observed by the Borough of Stewartstown at the time of enforcement of this Ordinance.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for juveniles as set forth herein to be upon any street, sidewalk, highway, park, or other public place after the hours set forth herein, provided the juvenile is going to or returning from their place of legal employment and in which event, such children shall present proof of said employment to any law enforcement officer.

Section 3. Penalties. Any juvenile violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars plus court costs for the first offense, a fifty (\$50.00) dollar fine plus court costs for the second offense, and one hundred (\$100.00) dollars plus court costs for the third and all subsequent offenses.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Stewartstown Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days upon its passage.
