**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF STEWARTSTOWN BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING VEHICLES OVER 25 FEET IN LENGTH ON  
PORTIONS OF BOROUGH ROADS**

---

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6109(e) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, as amended (“Vehicle Code”), Stewartstown Borough Council has caused an engineering and traffic investigation to be made in connection with prohibiting the operation of all motor vehicles as defined by the Vehicle Code exceeding more than 25 feet in length on Broadway Avenue, portions of South Hill Street, East Pennsylvania Avenue, Mill Street and Charles Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, said traffic and engineering investigation was completed on May 14, 2025, and contains recommendations that due to traffic conditions of Broadway Avenue, portions of South Hill Street, East Pennsylvania Avenue, Mill Street and Charles Avenue that the operation of vehicles over 25 feet in length be prohibited as set forth herein; and

**WHEREAS**, Stewartstown Borough Council pursuant to the authority granted to it under Section 6109(a)(7) and Section 4902(b) of the Vehicle Code and based upon the aforesaid engineering and traffic investigations, has determined that due to the existing traffic conditions and safety factors that the operation of vehicles as provided herein be prohibited on the Borough streets as set forth in this Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of Stewartstown Borough as follows:

**SECTION 1: Vehicle Restrictions.** The operation of all vehicles exceeding 25 feet in length, except school buses, emergency vehicles and vehicles making local deliveries to residences are prohibited on the following streets and locations:

Entire length of Broadway Avenue:

South Hill Street from the entrance to Rutter’s Farm Store to Church Street;

East Pennsylvania Avenue from North Main Street (SR0024) to Heather Drive;

Mill Street from North Main Street (SR0024) to North Hill Street; and

Charles Street from North Main Street (SR0024) to High Street.

**SECTION 2: Traffic Control Device.** All of the above streets shall be appropriately posted by official signs as approved by the Secretary of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as set forth in the aforesaid engineering and traffic investigations.

**SECTION 3: Violation and Penalty.** Any person operating a motor vehicle in violation of the prohibition imposed under this Ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall upon conviction be sentenced to pay a fine and costs as shall be provided under applicable provisions under the Vehicle Code which may be in effect at the time of the commission of the offense.


**SECTION 4: Repealer.** All prior ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 5: Severability.** If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

**SECTION 6: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective five days after the date of its enactment as provided by law.
