ORDINANCE NO. 2026-03

**AN ORDINANCE OF STEWARTSTOWN BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING ON
A PORTION OF KINGS WAY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 6109(e) of the Vehicle Code, Act of June 17, P.L. 162, No. 81, as amended, the Stewartstown Borough Council has caused an engineering and traffic investigation to be made for the purpose of determining safe travel conditions on a portion of Kings Way; and

WHEREAS, said traffic and engineering investigation was completed on January 20, 2026, and contains a recommendation that parking should be restricted on a portion of Kings Way; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council, pursuant to the authority granted to it under §6109(a)(1) and 3353(d) of the Vehicle Code to prohibit stopping, standing and parking based upon the aforesaid engineering and traffic investigation, has determined that due to the width of the street; stopping standing and parking should be restricted on the west side of Kings Way;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and duly ordained by the Stewartstown Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF NO STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING

Pursuant to the authority granted under § 6109(a)(1) of the Vehicle Code to prohibit stopping, standing and parking, it is hereby established that stopping, standing and parking are prohibited at all times on the west side of Kings Way.

SECTION 2. DESIGNATION OF NO PARKING

The section on the above street on which no stopping, standing or parking is imposed under section 1. of this Ordinance shall be appropriately designated by no parking signs (sign no. R8-3) spaced throughout the restriction in a manner that allows a sign to be visible at all times. The sign message shall be no parking symbol sign, with arrow plaque.

SECTION 3. PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) in accord with § 3353 of the Vehicle Code, or such other fines and costs as shall be provided under the applicable provisions of the Vehicle Code which may be in effect at the time of the commission of the offense.

SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced by any Police Officer having authority in Stewartstown Borough, and any other individual authorized under law.

SECTION 5. INTERPRETATION

The provisions of this Ordinance shall not be taken or construed to conflict with or otherwise limit the provisions of any of other statute or ordinance imposing any other or greater requirements, or restrictions, and in the event of any such duplication the provisions imposing the greater requirements or restriction shall prevail.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 7. REPEALER

All prior ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall become effective five days after the date of its enactment as provided by law.
