Winter is coming!! Please be aware of these important Ordinances to keep our town safe! All of these Ordinances may be read in their entirety on our website, www.stewartstown.org

· 2005-05—Snow Emergency Plan Ordinance

Phase 1 of the Borough's Snow Emergency Plan prohibits parking on all Borough streets including State roads once the Snow Emergency is in effect. Police, fire, ambulance & other emergency vehicles are exempt from this restriction. The Ordinance allows for any parked or abandoned vehicle in violation to be towed to an area selected by the Borough. All towing & storage charges will be the responsibility of the vehicle owner.

Phase 2 of the Snow Emergency Plan prohibits parking on all Borough streets including State roads, as stated above but also prohibits motor vehicles to travel on such streets & roads, excluding all emergency vehicles.

·2004-02—Snow Removal Ordinance

This Ordinance requires snow & ice to be removed within 24 hours after the cessation of snow, sleet or freezing rain.

2004-08—Open Burning Ordinance

November is open burning month with these restrictions (excludes cooking & entertainment fires):

- -No unattended fires.
- —No burning within 50 feet of a building or property line, other than cooking or entertainment fires.
- —No burning of construction materials, plastics, tires or other products likely to emit noxious fumes.

Stewartstown Senior Center update

The Center has reopened on September 13th and is serving hot meals on Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday. Seniors have the option of eating on site or taking meals to go. On Wednesdays, two frozen meals may be taken home.

Although all activities have not been planned yet, the Center will be open Monday thru Wednesday from 9am-1pm with Art Class on Wednesdays from 10am-11:30am.

Reminder of trash bill increase

Effective December 1st, 2021 through December 1st, 2022, Borough residents will see a \$4 increase on their quarterly trash bill, going from \$89/qtr. to \$93/qtr.

This is an unfortunate, yet unavoidable increase due to employee shortages at Penn Waste and rising fuel costs.

Trash collection is a service Stewartstown Borough provides. All Borough residents will receive a bill whether or not you use the service. Two collections are offered per week—1 on Tuesday, 1 on Friday with recyclables collected on Tuesdays also. In addition, one large item can be sat out for collection each Friday.

<u>Recycling Crisis</u>—Penn Waste continues to stress the importance of recycling restrictions. **How can you help?** Many items making their way into our recycling bins are simply NOT recyclable; they're **trash**.

Please sort your discarded materials and be vigilant about what you're recycling. These types of items are NOT recyclable:

Plastic bags (the kind from the grocery store), packaging material (bubble wrap, Styrofoam packing peanuts, plastic or foam packaging inserts), gift wrapping paper, aluminum foil and/or foil serving trays, medical waste, light bulbs, plastic hangers, Christmas lights and extension cords, any type of clothing, linens, food or liquid. Educate yourself on other items Penn Waste can recycle by going to www.recyclemorepa.com and remember this phrase, "When in doubt, throw it out!"

Electronic Recycling—York County Solid Waste Authority's Residential Electronics Recycling Program is **free** and open to York County residents ONLY on the following dates and times:

Monday through Friday from 8am to 4pm

Saturday from 8am to noon

The drop off facility is located at the York County Resource Recovery Center, 2651 Blackbridge Road, York, PA. (717) 845-1066.

<u>Accepted items</u>: computers, monitors, televisions, networking devices, printing devices, audio and video devices, communication devices, lab and measurement devices, telecommunication devices, power supplies, microwaves, peripherals, wire and cabling.

Not accepted: Fossil fuels, infectious and biological waste, any media contaminated with oil, any liquid, chemicals, oils, powders, any equipment that contains chemicals, freon or radioactive components, smoke detectors.
