- **HARPFEST 2022—Saturday, July 2nd** (rain date is Sunday, July 3rd)—The Bull Guys, LLC will provide various inflatable attractions for kids from 4:30pm-8:00pm. Tickets will be available for purchase at the HARP tent located across from HARP's concession stand. (Early Bird tickets on sale from 4pm-5pm). Ticket prices will be posted on the HARP website closer to the day of the event. Food vendors will include: Brickers, Stoney's Burgers, Premium Shaved Ice, Taco House & Boy Scout Troop 27 will be in HARP's concession stand with food.
